Certifications Glossary

We are committed to quality and standards in chair durability, sustainability and safety. Below are our certifications explained.

Australasian Furnishing Research and Development Institute



AFRDI Approved Products. Advanta has several Australasian Furnishing Research and Development Institute (AFRDI) tested products. AFRDI operates a national system of quality testing and certification for furniture, furniture components and related products and materials, with the aim of lifting quality and longevity, safety, suitability for purpose and ultimately, benefiting sustainability through conservation of resources.

Environmental Product Label – Eco 5 Rated



Products marked with our Eco 5 Rating have been internally assessed against strict environmental criteria and are considered better for the environment and human health. Eco 5 is an Advanta internal assessment tool and is not a third-party certification. The Eco 5 assessment is an internal checklist aligned to commercial furniture sustainability factors, covering materials, harmful substances, emissions, expected lifecycle, packaging, separability and recyclability. At Advanta, we cross-check new product development and production against product life and stewardship, identification and information, padding, fabrics/upholstery, timber/natural materials, adhesives, and coatings or treatments, including checks at every stage from design to manufacture and end-of-life.

BIFMA (Business + Institutional Furniture Manufacturers Association)



Advanta has a number BIFMA certified products. BIFMA certification ensures furniture meets rigorous safety, durability, and sustainability standards for commercial use. Products tested to BIFMA standards are built to perform reliably in demanding environments.

CATAS



CATAS is a leading European certification and testing body for furniture and wood-based products. Several Advanta products carry this certification. A CATAS certified product guarantees high performance, durability, and compliance with international safety and quality standards.

FSC Timber (Forest Stewardship Council)



Carrying this certification means that the timber comes from responsibly managed forests that provide environmental, social, and economic benefits. It ensures sustainable sourcing and helps protect forests for future generations.

GREENGUARD



GREENGUARD Certification confirms that a product meets strict chemical emissions limits, contributing to healthier indoor air quality. It's ideal for spaces where people spend extended time, such as offices and schools.

Ergonomist Endorsed



This mark means the chair has been independently assessed by a Certified Professional Ergonomist who confirms that the chair design meets the required standards for ergonomic compliance.

Eco 5 Rated Environmental Product Label Explained

Products bearing the Eco 5 Rated label have been internally assessed against stringent environmental criteria and are good for the environment and human health. The Eco 5 Rating assessment considers criteria including materials, harmful substances, expected life cycle, packaging, separability, recyclability, and emissions that are harmful to the environment. Eco 5 is an internal Advanta rating and is not an independently verified or third-party certification.

To achieve an Advanta Eco 5 Rating, products must meet the following 12 criteria (where applicable): Product Life, Product Stewardship, Emissions, Separability, Recyclability, Packaging, Product Identification, Product Information, Harmful Substances, Padding Materials, Fabrics/Upholstery Materials, and Timber & Natural Materials.



Eco 5 Rating Assessment Criteria

1	Product Life	Expected product life exceeds 12 years under normal use	7	Separability	The product is sufficiently separable into constituent materials
2	Product Stewardship	Product can be returned to Advanta and processed through our End-of-Life "Take Back" Program	8	Emissions	The product does not produce emissions that are harmful to the environment

Advanta's End-of-Life 'Take-Back' Program

Advanta's Product Stewardship End-of-Life 'Take-Back' program promotes sustainable disposal by allowing the return of certified products after their useful life.

Products Re-Purposed

Products are accepted free of charge if returned unassembled and uncontaminated within five years of delivery. Once returned, items are either resold, donated, or dismantled for recycling, ensuring minimal waste and supporting environmental responsibility. This initiative is available exclusively to the original purchasers of Advanta products.

Environmental Stewardship

Product stewardship recognises everyone involved in the production, supply and use of products and sharing responsibility for the environmental impact throughout a product's life cycle, from production through to disposal. It aims to avoid and reduce waste and increase recycling and resource recovery.

Designed for Longevity

The vital initial step in the product cycle is superior product design. Our products are designed and manufactured to withstand the demands of the commercial environment and the use of premium materials is meshed with the continuous addition of new features to extend our products' original life-span (First-life).

Completing the Eco-Cycle

Advanta's Product Stewardship End-of-Life 'Take-Back' Program completes the eco-cycle and assists with the management and disposal of our products at the end of their useful life with the original user.

How Does It Work?

We will receive and dispose of products manufactured by us free of charge (certified products only) provided they are returned unassembled and in an uncontaminated condition within 5 years from delivery date.

If transport to our premises is required, the charge for this service is on a 'not-for-profit' basis and the current price will be quoted on application.

This Product Stewardship End-of-life 'Take-Back' Program is only available to the original purchaser of the product.

Returned products will be either re-sold at auction or donated to recognised charity organisations to continue their useful lifespan, or if unsaleable or beyond re-use, dismantled and have the components sorted by material and sent to approved commercial recycling outlets.
